President	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Be the primary youth contact for the organization-Have a clear idea of the goals to be accomplished-Be able to properly lead and carry out meetings-Carry out the group's decisions and wishes-Learn to delegate responsibilities effectively-Be impartial, fair, and courteous-Schedule regular meetings for the organization, as well as separate meetings for the officers
Vice President	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Take over the president's responsibilities when he/she is unable to carry them out-Have a working knowledge of meeting procedures to assist in running meetings-Work with the president and leaders in planning and executing goals
Secretary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Record and keep accurate records including addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, etc.-Take accurate minutes during the meetings-Be sure to take motions down accurately-Assist in sending correspondence for the organization-If unable to attend, be sure to assign a representative to assume your duties
Treasurer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Keep track of all transactions and know the status of the organization's accounts-Prepare a current budget and present at every meeting-Keep copies of all receipts, etc.-Should be comfortable with math
Historian	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Keep a record of the group's accomplishments & activities-Collect pictures & news clippings about the group or its members-Organize a meaningful & memorable scrapbook for the year-Should be creative
Regional Directors	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Act as a director/representative/contact for those members in a particular region-Relay information, ideas, problems, etc.-North, South, East, West
